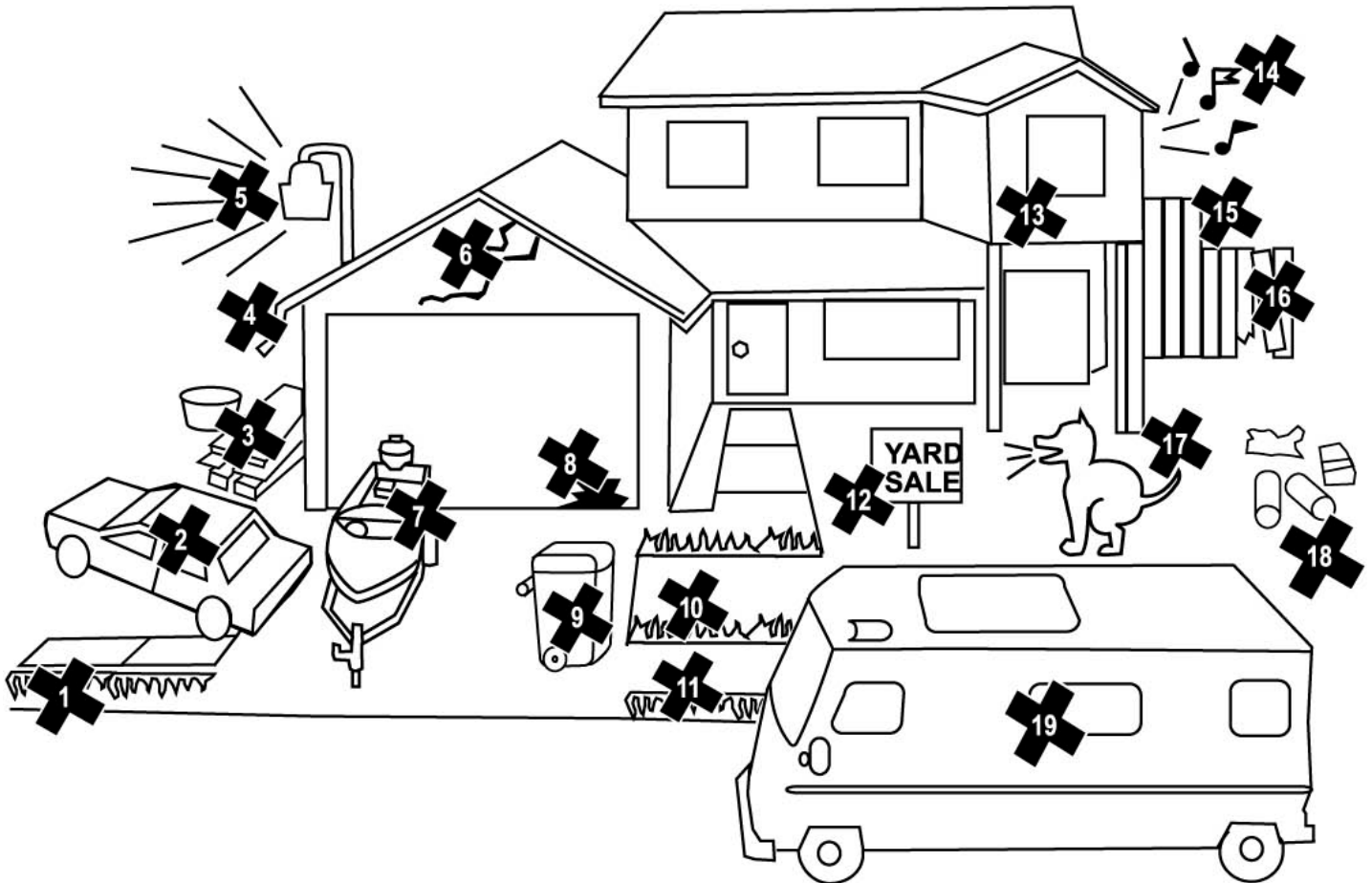


Common Deed Restrictions Violations

Your Inwood Forest Neighbors Are Committed To Living In A Neighborhood That Is Neat, Quiet And Safe!

Be A Good Neighbor



1. Edge your curbs
2. No parking on unpaved areas
3. No building materials, appliances or other materials visible from street.
4. Repair gutters.
5. Don't shine out door lights into your neighbors yard. Prohibited by city ordinance.
6. Repair walls and paint.
7. No boats or trailers
8. Replace rotted wood and paint
9. Trash can out of sight except trash day.
10. Mow grass frequently.
11. Edge all curbs.
12. No signs and no businesses. (Exceptions See Deed Restrictions)
13. No unapproved structural changes (For Approval See Deed Restrictions)
14. No outside noise or music that can disturb your neighbors. Prohibited by city ordinance Enforced by H.P.D.
15. Correct fence size.
16. Quickly repair all fences as needed.
17. No dogs outside fence areas. City ordinance requires a poop pickup when walking dogs. Keep your dog from disturbing your neighbors.
18. No litter. Pick up any trash on you property including sidewalk and street gutters.
19. No RV, campers etc parked on street or property.
