

## **Prohibited Yard Parking Ordinance**

Inwood Forest is covered by the city of Houston's prohibited yard parking ordinance. Parking is not allowed on any yards in Inwood Forest. ## **Trash Can and Recycle Cart Storage**

Trash cans and recycle carts should be stored so that they are not **visible from the street**. Preferably, they should be stored in your backyard or garage, not in the front of your house or in your driveway. Your neighbors don't want to see your trash can and recycle cart when they drive by your house or look out their windows.

## **ACC Requests**

If you are planning on doing any work to the exterior of your home, please complete an Architectural Control Committee (ACC) request and submit it to the board **prior to** beginning the work. Please note that if you are installing a fence, you need ACC approval. If you are installing a wood fence, the pickets will need to be on the outside of the fence for any part of the fence that is visible from the street or green space. Also, please check with the board regarding the maximum height the fence can be for your lot. The maximum height includes a rot board, if you are going to have one. The fence that you are replacing may not have been in compliance with the deed restrictions when it was constructed. That is why it is important to submit an ACC request prior to installing or replacing a fence. You can also contact the board at [board@ifcia.com](mailto:board@ifcia.com) for more information.
